On-site conference registration does not apply to competition registration. Students entered in TEAMS competition must be pre-registered.

Attendance at the Conference

The TSA, Inc. Board of Directors requires a minimum of one adult coach or chaperone for no more than ten students. State-level coaches may name an adult chaperone to serve as the coach. Coaches and/or chaperones must register for the conference, pay the registration fee, and be in attendance for the duration of the conference. There are no restrictions on the number of adult coaches and chaperones who may attend. All teachers, parents, supervisors and teacher-educators are eligible to serve in this capacity.

All adults, including parents, must register for the conference. No student may attend, compete, or participate without physical presence of an adult chaperone throughout the duration of the conference.

In order to attend and/or compete at the National TSA Conference, all students, including students who are 18 years of age (as well as graduates of this school year) are required to attend the conference with a coach, parent or adult chaperone.

A student must meet the criteria listed below to be eligible to attend the national conference:

- Have the approval of the TEAMS coach.
- Have the written approval of a parent or guardian, through completion of the Parent Authorization Form.
- Be in attendance throughout the duration of the national conference.

Conference Expenses

TSA is a non-profit organization. The conference registration fees are predetermined based upon an analysis of all expenditures necessary to ensure a worthwhile and positive experience for all who attend. Conference registration fees cover various expense categories, including conference supplies such as ID badges, ribbons, programs, conference awards (plaques, certificates, etc.); conference special events (mixer, opening ceremony), facilities (convention center, meeting rooms); and other related expenses such as insurance and security.

^{**} Guest includes those who are not TEAMS competitors. Parents serving as coaches must pay the full coach fee, not the guest fee.

^{***} Child includes those age 10 and under accompanied by a registered parent. Children over the age of 10 who are not competing or participating as a TSA chapter member must pay the guest fee.
